November 11, 1908 - May 21, 2003

Lena M. Biondolillo, 94, formerly of 78 Hazzard St. and the Frewsburg Rest Home, died at 11:25 A.M. Monday (May 19, 2003) in Heritage Park Health Care Center. She was born November 11, 1908 in Brant, N.Y., a daughter of Frank and Catarina Ricotta Morgano. Prior to retiring in 1973, she had been employed as a tester and inspector at Marlin Rockwell Corp., and in earlier years had worked at the former Empire Worsted Mills and Jamestown Plywood Corp. She was a parishioner of St. James Roman Catholic Church. Widowed at a young age, she met the challenge of being a single mother by her devotion to the raising of her 2 sons, along with her great affection for her nephew, Frank Muscato, to whom she was like a mother.
